Company JAVYS, a.s. hosted the 59th conference of the international Technical Advisory Group for nuclear facilities decommissioning from 12th of October to 16th of October 2015.

The Technical Advisory Group (TAG) works on the basis of exchange of the scientific-technical information in the nuclear facilities decommissioning (CPD Treaty). It was established under the auspices of the OECD-NEA and its validity has been continuously extended in five-year cycles for 30 years. During this time it demonstrated a high level of the added value for the participating Member states. The CPD Treaty represents an agreement between individual companies, implementing the activities of the nuclear facilities decommissioning in countries of the OECD-NEA (Europe, Asia, and North America) operation.

The group works under the auspices of the OECD-NEA (Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development Nuclear Energy Agency).

26 experts from 12 countries of Europe and Asia participated in the 59th itinerant session organized by company JAVYS, a.s. for the first time. The conference aimed at discussing the progress in the nuclear facilities decommissioning projects currently under implementation around the world as well as addressing the issues of the technical challenges brought by specific activities performed in this sector.
